FEAST

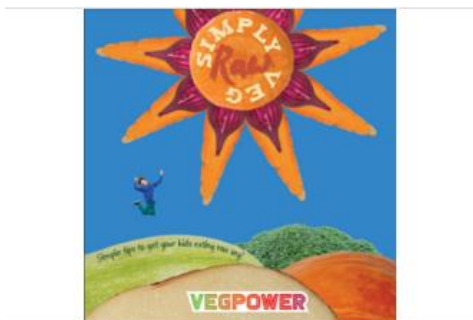
FEAST brings the fun to the school holidays, offering loads of different activities for everyone to take part in.
