The coach will arrive at Sharow school at 5.45am ready for a prompt departure at 6.00am.

It will then pick-up at Skelton Newby Hall School at 6:15am.

The coach will make a couple of comfort stops en-route.

You can bring snacks to have for extra breakfast on the bus and a packed lunch which we'll eat when we arrive in Central London at approximately 12pm.





After lunch we will head to the Natural History Museum for 1pm.

We will leave there about 4pm then get the bus to the Rainforest café for dinner at 5:30pm





After dinner we will then walk round to our Youth Hostel, unpack and settle down for the night.





Breakfast will be served at 8.00am.

We will then take the coach to St Paul's Cathedral where we will have a guided tour, which includes a trip up inside the dome.





We'll have our lunch at St Paul's

We'll then take the coach to the London Eye.

After our flight we will then visit the 4D cinema experience.





After our London Eye Experience, we will embark on a guided walk (or guided coach tour in the event of bad weather) around Central London.







Dinner in the evening is booked for 5.30pm at Pizza Express.



After our evening meal, we will head to the Lyceum Theatre to see the 7.30pm performance



After the show we will then head back to the Youth Hostel.



Breakfast will be served at 8.00am.

We will then pack and load our bags onto the bus and leave the hostel at 9:30am and travel to the Tower of London.

We'll eat our lunch by the River Thames before enjoying a boat trip along the river to meet our bus back at Westminster.

At 2.00pm we will depart London for our journey back to school.

We will stop for tea at McDonalds on the way back and arrive back at Skelton at approximately time of 9.30pm and Sharow at 9:45pm.

#### What next — over the next 4 weeks?

- Activities for the children to get to know each other and the staff
- Children request a dorm group (Teachers will allocate)
- Kit list, menu choices & finalized itinerary send out
- Medical information forms to be completed week before Easter Holidays
- Emergency procedure sheet send out

#### Some questions asked?

- Children are allowed to take cameras (disposable cameras recommended)
- NO electrical devices allowed including phones, tablets, game consoles
- Snacks can be taken by the children but staff will monitor what/when it will be appropriate to have these snacks: bus journey to/from London, mid morning/afternoon
- An amount of spending money can be taken amount will be finalised on kit list and be the responsibility of the child.
- Prescribed medication MUST be identified on the medical form and ALL medication MUST be individually named & handed in to the LEAD TEACHER by the parent/carer in named zip-lock bag BEFORE the child joins the coach.
