Here at Sharow we are launching an exciting art competition for all pupils in our school. The winning entries will be judged in school and then sent to the Royal Academy of Arts in London. Then, your artwork will be viewed and judged by a panel of experienced and passionate artists and arts professionals and the selected pieces will be shown in their online exhibition. Some of the artworks will also be shown at the Royal Academy of Arts. The judges are looking for imagination, originality and skill.

How to enter:

- 1. Each student can submit one piece of artwork and there is **no theme**.
- 2. Send your completed artwork into school.
- 3. Provide some information about the piece such as title, size, and a little text about the artwork and why you made it.
- 4. The artwork can be made using any material; it can be a painting, sculpture, photograph, installation, video, drawing, or a combination.
- 5. Remember, judges are looking for imagination, originality and skill.

6. <u>Entries need to be returned to school by 20th March 2024. Entries submitted after this</u> date will not be entered.
