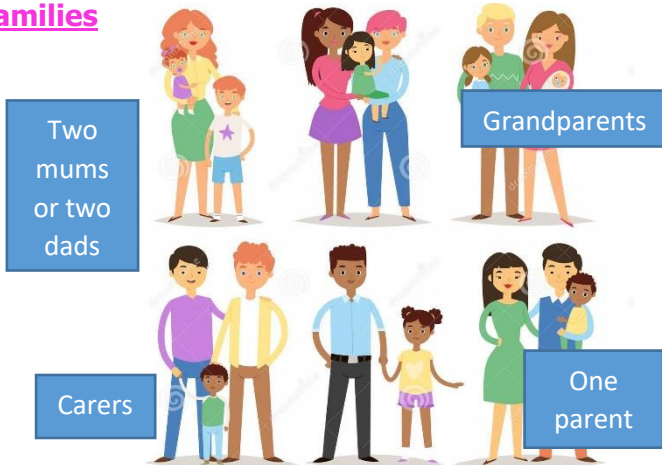

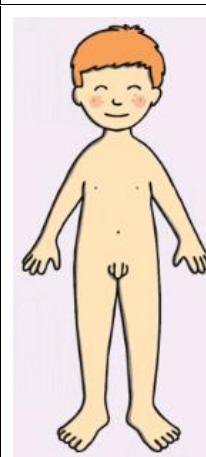
Family	A group of people who love, trust and care for one another	Cooperate	Work together
