

VOCABULARY

stalk	the main stem	bark	tough protective outer layer on a trunk
root	the part of a plant that grows underground	leaf	the part of a tree or plant that are flat, thin and usually green
stem	the thin upright part of a plant on which the flowers and leaves grow	nutrients	a substance that provides nourishment for the essential maintenance of life and for growth
bulb	a root shaped like an onion that grows into a flower or plant	seed	the small, hard part from which a new plant grows
trunk	the large main stem from which the branches grow	bud	a compact growth on a plant that turns into a leaf, flower or shoot
flower	the part of a plant which is often brightly coloured and grows at the end of the stem	temperature	the intensity of heat
