	Muslims like to pray 5 times each day, following a pattern of actions be- fore each prayer time. They wash their faces, hands up to their elbows, heads, and feet up to their ankles. They then place their prayer mat to face the direction of <b>Mecca</b> and bow.		
	Christians may pray by lighting candles, kneeling, putting their hands together and closing their eyes, through music or through silence and meditation.
