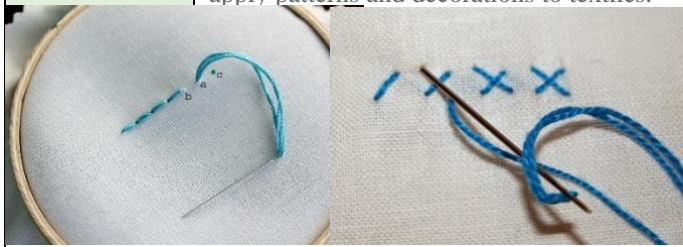


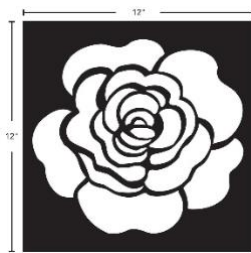
Vocabulary

<p>Back stitch</p>	<p>a stitch sewn one stitch length backward on the front side and two stitch lengths forward on the reverse side to form a solid line of stitching on both sides</p>	<p>Stamps</p>	<p>impress a pattern or mark using an engraved or inked block or die or other instrument.</p>
<p>Cross stitch</p>	<p>a stitch formed of two stitches crossing each other.</p>	<p>Stencils</p>	<p>a technique for reproducing designs by passing ink or paint over holes cut in cardboard or metal onto the surface to be decorated.</p>
<p>Fabric paint</p>	<p>Fabric paint is a type of paint which is specifically designed for use on textiles. It is often used to create custom craft projects, and is also used on a commercial scale to apply patterns and decorations to textiles.</p>	<p>Textiles</p>	<p>a type of cloth or woven fabric.</p>
