Expressive Arts and Design



Papier Mache planets to create the Solar System.

Make an Alien using playdoh, pipe cleaners and googly eyes, then add some underpants!

Create their own clay aliens.

Mathematics

- Find and represent 9 and 10
- Compare numbers to 10
- Conceptual subitising to 10
- 1 more / 1 less
- Composition to 10
- Bonds to 10 (2 parts)

Physical Development

Corn flour to create goop to explore hidden objects! Add fluorescent paint.



Fine motor skills- pompoms (planets) and tweezers.


Move around like an alien to various space music.

Communication and Language

Create a small world planet with aliens and different textured surfaces.

Alien Spaceship to use for role play- include a control panel with lots of 'twiddly' bits and bobs to investigate (keyboards, different material/fabrics for dressing up like an alien)
