

All About Me - Week Six

The theme for our learning this week will be 'My Feelings'. Next week we will be thinking about how we change as we grow older. It would be really helpful if your child could bring in photographs of themselves as a baby.

Communication and Language

A display about different emotions will be added to the classroom this week. We will support the children to use it to talk about how they are feeling throughout the day.

Literacy

Our focus is on poetry this week, exploring two poems by Michael Rosen. The children will be encouraged to join in with the patterned language and write a response to one of the poems.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning the song "If You're Happy and You Know It" and making up new verses based on different emotions.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be Reading the story 'In my heart' by Jo Witek and identifying different emotions. We will think about how people show emotions in different situations.

Mathematics

We will be using the story 'The Colour Monster', as a basis for our work on comparing numbers. The children will sort objects into groups based on colour and talk about which has the most/fewest.

Physical Development

We are planning to listen to pieces of music that suggest different emotions and create dances in response to them. The children will practise their scissor skills by cutting materials to use to create a colour collage.

Understanding the World

We will be thinking about what it means to belong to a community and asking the children to consider which communities they belong to.
