



All About Me – Week Four

We got our topic 'All about me' off to a great start over the last few weeks and are looking forward to continuing our learning this week, with a focus on "My Body".

<p><u>Communication and Language</u></p> <p>The children will play games and say rhymes to help them learn new vocabulary related to parts of the body.</p>	<p><u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u></p> <p>The children will be exploring diversity through activities and discussion about similarities and differences and understanding that we are all unique.</p>	<p><u>Physical Development</u></p> <p>We will be exploring how we can make lots of different movements using a wide range of body parts. We will also be finding out about how to care for our teeth.</p>
<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Our focus text for the week will be "From Head to Toe" by Eric Carle. The children will become confident with the repeated language of the story before creating their own page for the book.</p>	<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p><i>Matching, Sorting & Comparing.</i></p> <p>Sorting hoops and natural objects to sort, coloured buckets and matching coloured objects to sort, numeral flashcards to match to amounts sorted, tidying up – sorting objects to put away in the correct places.</p>	<p><u>Understanding the World</u></p> <p>What is it like at a doctors' surgery? We will be thinking about our previous experiences and deepening our understanding. We will also be finding out how to stay safe around medicines.</p>
<p><u>Expressive Arts and Design</u></p> <p>We will be setting up a new role play area based on a doctors' surgery. The children will have the chance to take on different roles and help to act out a simple storyline with their friends.</p>	<p><u>Ideas to Explore at Home</u></p> <p>Play a game of 'Simon Says', asking your child to make movements using different body parts.</p> <p>Encourage your child to go on a 'Matching Treasure Hunt'. Ask them to find items around the home that match. Can they make a pair? Talk about what is the same?</p> <p>Help your child to time two minutes as they brush their teeth.</p>
